If needed, you may also be counselled on the benefits of dental sealants and mouthguards for the prevention of bruxism and TMJ. And, what visit would be complete without a thorough evaluation of personal oral hygiene to reinforce good at home care. Root scaling or planing may also be recommended to address gingivitis or other forms of gum disease.

Memphis dentists encourage parents to start their children on a lifetime of good dental health by bringing their children in for their first dental visit at approximately six months of age. Parents should introduce the concept of good oral hygiene to their children as early as possible, as even babies can develop tooth decay in their unerupted teeth.

For the times when problems do arise, your Memphis dentist will utilize the latest techniques available for filling cavities (using tooth colored fillings), root canal treatments, dentures, bridges and crowns. Tooth whitening procedures are on offer for those whose teeth have suffered the effects of years of tea, coffee and cola drinking. Tooth colored bonding and crown work will do the job if you have chipped or broken teeth. Porcelain veneers help with gaps in between teeth or teeth that are chipped or worn.
