

Help With Filing An Internet Domain Registration

It is not difficult to process an Internet domain registration. All it takes to register one or more domain names is an internet connection. Boiled down to the simplest terms, one needs to select a domain registrar, choose a domain name, enter the required registration information, and provide payment, as required by the registrar. However, if one is not familiar with these terms or the basic management of Internet domain registration it may not seem so straightforward. This can result in a reluctance to initiate the process. Not everyone has enough working knowledge of the terms to feel comfortable. Fortunately, all this can be put into perspective.

Domain means the Internet website itself. Domain name is the location of the site, often referred to as the Internet address. A website that has been accredited as a domain registrar will manage your Internet domain registration, collecting the necessary information, sending it to a central directory, and maintaining your registration records. You have a broad choice of sites which function as domain registrars. A Web host will not only process your Internet domain registration, but will help you build and maintain a website as well. Using a Web host for Internet domain registration may be a more comfortable option for those with limited technical knowledge.

The hardest part of completing an Internet domain registration may be finding an available domain name. The Internet domain name has a defined layout and must be one of a kind. Following the standard www the domain name consists of a name, then what is known as an extension. The most common extension is .com, but there are several others available. For instance, www.myname.net is a sample domain name format. It is wise to choose a name that indicates the nature of your website. The combination of the name and extension cannot be registered by anyone else. ICANN is the corporation which sees to the integrity of Internet domain registration. The InterNIC website provides access to the database of Internet domain registration data. The registry itself is WHOIS.

Fortunately, most Internet domain registrars provide a search to determine availability of the name you want. The search will tell you it is available or offer suggestions. You can also continue to search until you find one that is just right. Now you are on your way. Fill out the required information and file. Done! You have completed your Internet domain registration and the registrar will notify you by email when it is available.
